**Sixteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time** 

Entrance Antiphon: "See, I have God for my help. The Lord sustains my soul. I will sacrifice to you with willing heart, and praise your name, O Lord, for it is good." Ps 54 (53): 6, 8

**Communion Antiphon:** "Behold, I stand at the door and knock, says the Lord. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door to me, I will enter his house and dine with him, and he with me." Rev 3: 20

Reflection for this Sunday: The 16th Sunday in Ordinary Time presents a rich tapestry of themes hospitality, service, contemplation, and perseverance in hardship—woven through the stories of Abraham and Sarah, Martha and Mary, and the reflections of St. Paul. Abraham's generous welcome to three mysterious visitors, who many believe symbolize the Holy Trinity, teaches us the sacredness of hospitality offering the best of ourselves to others as an act of faith and reverence. Sarah's disbelief in the promise of a child mirrors our human doubts, yet her story reminds us that God's promises surpass our limitations. Similarly, in the Gospel, Martha and Mary embody the tension between action and contemplation. While Martha busily serves, Mary chooses to sit at Jesus' feet, showing that true discipleship requires both active service and reflective listening. Jesus gently affirms Mary's choice, emphasizing that contemplation anchors our service in love and purpose. St. Paul's message further deepens these lessons by inviting us to rejoice in our sufferings, viewing hardships not as obstacles but as paths to spiritual growth. Sarah's infertility and Martha's frustration reflect common struggles, yet both are transformed through encounters with the divine. Together, these readings call us to a deeper life of faith—welcoming others with love, finding Christ in both work and stillness, and trusting in God amid life's trials. As we live out these lessons, we are drawn closer to God and better equipped to reflect His presence in our daily lives. May we be like Abraham in hospitality, Martha in service, Mary in contemplation, and Paul in perseverance, growing ever stronger in our Christian journey.
